CUT: Teens and Self Injury producer/director Wendy Schneider today announced the release of a five minute production preview of the hour-long documentary. Downloadable at www.cutthemovie.com.

The film, featuring candid interviews with teens, parents, counselors and rock celebrities, is currently in the last stages of post-production, and remains slated for a fall release. It seeks to shine a light on a problem that directly affects up to four percent of the American population – in addition to their family and friends.

The film nears completion as “Cut,” a song on the latest album of alt-rock band Plumb, surges into the Top Five on the charts. Plumb frontwoman Tiffany Arbuckle Lee appears in the film, courtesy of Curb Records, and is featured in the production preview released today. Her interest in ‘cutting’ – and role as a public advocate – stems from a rabid discussion of the self injury among teens on her website's message board.

“That message board is evidence that teens are looking for a safe place to talk,” Schneider said. “Plumb's song lets people know they're not suffering alone, and it can spark those conversations. I hope this film does that too.”

Arbuckle Lee joins Shirley Manson of Garbage, herself a survivor of self-harm, in the film.

"This is a subject that has long been swept under the carpet," said Manson. "It needs to be talked about and it needs to be talked about now."

Schneider continues to seek funding for distribution. She is actively soliciting honorary producers and partners.
